## **Updates from the Schools & School Organizations**

VDV:

April:

April is Autism Awareness Month and acknowledged the week with a Spirit week as well as a school wide read aloud.

April 4th we had our 5th Grade DARE Graduation at 9:15am

The Girls on The Run Program has begun for our 3rd-5th grade students.

2nd grade classes explored the fire museum. Here they learned about Somerville fire department's history and had the opportunity to investigate a historical fire truck.

We had our VDV Variety Show that will showcase the talents of some of our 4th and 5th grade students. Students may be singing, dancing, hula hooping, telling jokes, etc.

April 7-11 was Week of the Young Child where we celebrated with various activities including a cereal box domino challenge where we had over 300 boxes that we donated to the Food Bank of Somerset County. During this time, we celebrated the importance of early education. Each day had a theme that was celebrated by PS-2nd grade students. Students also created their own songs to children's songs.

5th grade went on a field trip to the Jacobus House to learn about historical events that took place during the revolutionary war.

Our social workers met with each grade level to have lessons discussing the difference between tattling vs. telling.

The 3rd grade classes had presentations by Somerset County 4H on Pollination. Today our school nurses held their monthly Wellness Wednesday for our students and staff. This month's theme is focused on hygiene.

Tomorrow, staff will bring in their children to celebrate Take Your Child To Work. With the assistance of Mrs. White, two activities will occur for these children. Some staff have also planned various activities for their own students that explored various careers.

On Friday, our first grade students will have their Market Day as a culmination to their Social Studies unit on Goods and Services. Students chose to sell either a good or a service. Families have been invited.

#### SMS:

April is Lifesaver Month at SMS! Starting on Tuesday, April 1, all staff have bags of lifesavers that can be given to students when they observe other students helping, aka "being a lifesaver for," other students or staff! The lifesavers are an opportunity for us to acknowledge students when they spontaneously help those around them and encourage them to keep supporting each other when they get the chance. On April 1st and 2nd, SMS completed their third iReady diagnostic in preparation for state testing in May. The diagnostic data will drive building-level interventions and preparation.

On Wednesday, April 2nd, the SMS staff and students wore their Tie Dye or Rainbow colors in support of National World Autism Day.

On Thursday, April 3rd, SMS students were acknowledged and recognized for their achievement at the Paul Robeson Recognition night at Raritan Valley Community College. The Paul Robeson program is designed to highlight outstanding African American High School and Middle School students and is coordinated through RVCC. Each student was required to apply and was selected through an independent panel at Raritan Valley Community College. Five Somerville Middle School students were nominated for awards, and we had one winner of this very selective award.

On Thursday, April 10th, SMS conducted its final spring concert in the SMS auditorium. SMS students "rocked" the SMS auditorium for one final time before the SMS auditorium makeover commences. Mr. Loretti and Mr. Gibbins put on a wonderful performance highlighting all the talents that SMS students offer. On Friday, April 11th SMS held Career Day for all students. 16 different profession presentations were conducted in a round robin format for students to visit during their assigned PE class. The day was a great success and exposed SMS to the wide array of career pathways available to them once they leave the walls of SMS. Professions that students were able to visit with included: Finance/Financial Planner, College Professor, Assistant Prosecutor (Essex County NJ), Nurse, Scientist for Consumer Products Goods Industry, Sales/

Marketing/ Business Development Executive, Science/Medical Writer, Police Officer, Mechanical Engineer for the US Army and Picatinny Arsenal, Mortuary Practitioner, Project Manager for the Green Acres Program at the NJDEP, Head of Quality Department for skincare factory, Electrician (work for local IBEW), Architect, Trade Worker with heavy equipment, and a Retail banker.

Monday, 4/21, was Life Skills Day, which gave staff a chance to bring some different types of skills into the classroom than those that are usually included in the every day curriculum. Some of the topics included woodworking, stroke awareness (with a nurse guest speaker), understanding insurance, active listening, healthy relationships and conflict resolution, reading an analog clock, writing professional emails, kitchen safety, and so many more!
